

Responses to frequently asked questions:

1. TVUSD teachers have been participating in a statewide movement to increase funding for K-12 education. Our local teacher leadership has assured us their actions are not directed at the TVUSD community, Board, or Administration.
2. The District is not supporting or encouraging teachers to walk out. We have shared with their leadership facts related to the Governor's proposal and we are working to answer their questions.
3. If needed, notice of a school closure will be made via Constant Contact, IntouchK12 (Telephone Emergency Broadcast System), verified school and district social media accounts, and posting to our website.
4. A school closure may require the District to add a day to the end of the school year to meet the required 180 school days per Arizona law.

In the event of a school closure:

5. Agua Caliente and Tanque Verde Elementary - All CC Club and Youth Community Programs will continue to operate as scheduled. For those parents with students currently enrolled in CC Club, please watch for an email from the director for additional information.
6. Emily Gray Jr. High School - All athletics and after-school activities would be cancelled.
7. Tanque Verde High School - High School Interscholastic Athletics would continue regularly scheduled activities as planned. All other high school clubs and activities would be cancelled.
8. Organizations using our school facilities will continue to be able to do so even in the event of a school closure. Custodial staff will follow their regular schedule for facility access.
