Proposed bus loading/unloading for 2020-2021 School Year

Chris Rietz went over the Sunland proposal to relocate the ACES bus bay area  
To the front of the school again separated by fencing that would separate the bus bay  
from traffic. Hopefully the work will take place during the summer months to be ready for  
the 2020-21 school year.

Chris Rietz mentioned that increasing the amount of available parking or lot size will be  
added to the next bond for funding

Reduction of faculty/ staff at ACES
