Superintendent's Advisory Committee Proposal of needs of TVUSD Schools Capital Projects/Priorities for Potential Tax Bond

Chris Rietz explained how the Superintendent's Advisory Committee has formed to help determine the District needs. The council went through a list that was provided by the Superintendent and were asked to consider the following:

- Share information and collect feedback
- What investments should we make in our schools?
- How do we prioritize our needs as we enter our next decade of excellence?
- Rank/prioritize projects

Mrs. Rietz asked that the committee return their prioritized list and to add any items that they felt should be listed and considered. Items that were mentioned were safety features such as ADA compliance door openings, gate openings on fences that are more secure, adding security cameras on the campuses

Volunteer Support

Mr. Drummond will be working on another phase of the Water Shed Project on March 7 and we will need volunteers. We will send a Coyote Communique notice to invite parents and families to help participate. It is hard to get volunteers as everyone is so busy or may have young children. We discussed offering some type of event for the kids so that parents would be able to volunteer- possibly a movie in the MPR or field games.

Next year we will need to rely heavily on volunteers during the school day due to the cutback of classified staff. We are looking for volunteer support that is intentional, organized, structured, and consistent. It was suggested that we contact neighborhood HOA's to send out the invitation for volunteers. We should also ask businesses to sponsor a class or grade level with volunteers. What would the cost be to have each person finger printed? It is important that we know who is on our campuses.

Parking Lot/ Bus Zone Update

The NAU Student Engineer Team will not be able to assist with the parking lot surveying. We are waiting to hear back from the Fire Marshall to assist us with where fire zones should be located and to give feedback about moving the bus loading zones.

Other Items of Discussion:

The committee mentioned that parents were not aware of Pajama Dress up Day. Chris Rietz explained that Student Council wanted to give an immediate reward for filling our bucket, by claiming Pajama Day the day after our school assembly. The students would have an immediate reward instead of having to wait weeks for it. Next time we will send an email announcing the dress up day.

This caused discussion that not all parents are receiving information sent home with their students or the Coyote Communicate. How can we assure that we have all parent emails? Should we require parents to subscribe to the communicate as this is our primary communication with families? What would be the easiest way to get emails? Kris Condra will check with the other sites.
